Opening Reception and Certificate Graduation: Saturday, April 29, 2017 from 3 - 5pm

Eligibility: Open to all students enrolled in Art Institute classes from April 2016 – March 2017. Entered artwork must be created within the last 2 years and will be accepted in any medium or subject-matter that reflects your personal style. Artwork inspired by an Art Institute class theme is encouraged but not required. **Sonoran Desert bird-themed artwork is encouraged to help celebrate this year's Arizona-Sonora Desert Museum Gala theme, "Wings Over the Sonoran Desert."**

Framing, Media and Presentation: Students may submit 1 piece of original art in any media. Giclee prints or reproductions of drawings and paintings are not allowed. **Art must be framed and wired for hanging.** No saw tooth or clip hangers. 2017 Art Institute Certificate Students are required to submit 5 original artworks (please contact the Art Institute office for more information and a separate entry form).

Labeling of Art: Art must be labeled on the back with the artist's name, title of piece, medium, date, and sale price or NFS (not for sale). Each piece must be signed by the artist (front, back, or frame).

Sales: Art for sale is strongly encouraged. When sold, the Art Institute will retain a 20% commission and forward a check to the artist for the remaining 80% within 30 days of the show closing.

Entry Deadline: Entry forms due by Monday, March 27th, 2017

Art Drop-off: Entrants are required to drop-off their artwork to the Art Institute office in the Baldwin Education Building at the Desert Museum. Packaging materials will be removed and taken away by the artist. Please drop off artwork during one of the following times, or call to make an appointment outside of these dates and times:

- Monday Friday, 9:00am 3:00pm, April 10th 14th
- Saturday & Sunday 11:00am 2:00pm, April 15th & 16th
- Art must be received by 3:00pm Monday, April 17th. Art will not be accepted after this time.

Art Pick-up: Entrants must pick-up art by appointment or select one of the following options:

- Monday, May 29th 10:00am 3:00pm from the Ironwood Gallery (preferred)
- Tuesday Thursday, May 30th June 2nd 9:00am 3:00pm from Art Institute Office. Please call or email prior to your arrival to expedite pickup.
- Arrange to ship art for a fee of \$20-\$40 depending on size and weight of art. Shipping arrangements must be finalized with the Art Institute prior to June 9th. Contact the Art Institute office for more information.
