## **Materials List**

**Graphite Pencils** - 2H, HB or F, 2B, 4B Whichever brand you prefer; Steadtler, Faber Castell, etc.  
Berol Turquoise is my personal favorite.

**Pencil Sharpener** - hand, battery, or electric

**Tortillion, Blending Stump or Blending Stick** - A furry, double ended, cylinder of paper. Not a colored pencil blender. Not a spiral roll of paper.

**Easers** - One kneaded eraser

Also, one White, non abrasive eraser such as Sanford Tuff Stuff eraser stick, Pentel "Clic"  
General's Tri-Tip or other non abrasive white eraser  
Optional - Electric Eraser - great for fine detail work and bright whites!

**Erasing Shield** - nice for detailed or refined work

**Brush** - Cheap, 2" wide paint brush (for removing eraser crumbs). A Hake brush also works well.

**Ruler** - Best if it is transparent and well marked

**Papers** - Smooth Bristol, Vellum, or Bristol Vellum 11" X 14" or 9" X 12" pad  
Sketching Notebook 9" X 12" or cheap white paper (not newsprint)  
Tracing Paper 9" X 12" pad

**Removable Tape** - One roll of 3M removable tape, drafting tape, artist's tape or the equivalent

**Bag or case** - to carry all your supplies in
