Materials List

- Sketch pad, preferably one that can take washes, no larger than 9" x 12" (Aquabee super deluxe 808 is ideal as it will take light washes beautifully and has a wonderful tooth for drawing).
- Graphite Drawing pencil 2H, HB
- Pencil sharpener
- Kneadable eraser
- White Plastic eraser or a pink pearl
- Colored pencils, Prismacolor preferably
- Set of "Pitt" Pigma Brushes – "Shades of Grey" by Faber Castell, waterproof - (felt brush in pen form) or comparable. Available at Sarnoff...ask!
- Compact watercolor set, inexpensive just fine
- Pad of watercolor paper, 9" x 12" (*if you already have it*, do not buy unless your sketch pad cannot take washes!
- Brushes
- Small water bottle with top or empty film canister
- Approx. 12" x 16" Masonite or support board

Personal:

- Hat
- Sunscreen
- Collapsible, portable lightweight stool (inexpensive fishing stool for example). The Art Institute has stools that you may borrow during class.
- Drinking water
- Backpack or tote with all supplies within!
