## WHAT, WHEN AND WHERE?

Dog Days takes place at the Humane Society's Companions for Life Center at 3465 E. Kleindale, approximately one block from the shelter, unless otherwise specified in attached paperwork. The Center has security fences, air-cooled classroom areas, landscaped grassy yards for animal-related activities and other excellent facilities. Included in the registration cost is a Humane Society namebadge, prizes, keepsakes, educational information and a free recognition party. Sessions run daily from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

## SCHOLARSHIPS AND DISCOUNTS:

Hand-in-Paw Kids Club members can get a discount on most summer programs. Limited scholarships may be available for kids with financial or special needs. Guardians and caseworkers are invited to contact us by phone for application details. Scholarship recipients will be notified by phone and email.

## WHAT IS THIS YEAR'S CAMP THEME?

This year, children will be divided up by age groups and topics will depend on the group that children are registered for. Topics will include but are not limited to: New Pet Ownership and Responsibility, Animal Handling and Bite Safety, Kindness and Compassion, Pet Adoption Promotions, Domestication of Cats and Dogs, Native Wild Animal Habitat and Ecology, Building Pet Living Areas and Careers. Participating children will engage in classroom, artistic, cooperative and hands-on projects that will stimulate their minds and their consciousness.

### FRESHMEN PROGRAMS (ages 6-8)

#### **Pampered Paws & Cuddle Companions**

Spend part of your summer bathing dogs, baking pet treats, toys and gifts and spending hours a day with kittens, rabbits, guinea pigs and playful pups at the Humane Society of Southern Arizona.

#### **Pet Vet: Caring for Furry & Four-Legged Friends at the Children's Museum Tucson**

**Monday-Thursday, July 15-18**

The HSSA and the Children's Museum team up to focus on our wonderful furry friends. Campers will explore animal careers, maintenance and safety with the Children's Museum Pet Vet and Bodyology exhibits. They will care for an array of live animals, and enjoy a field trip to the HSSA on the last day.

#### **Featured Pet Productions**

**Monday-Thursday, June 10-13**

Participants will assist with adoptions promotions of shelter residents by decorating cages; promoting dog adoptions through YouTube videos and social media promotions and assisting with adoptions of these wonderful pets.

### **When Dogs were Wolves and Cats were Wild**

**Monday-Thursday, July 8-11**

Take a walk on the wild side of pets as we compare domestic dogs, cats, birds, rodents and reptiles to their wild counterparts. How are our pets' needs different from their wild relatives'? And how do zoos best care for their animals? Spend two days exploring the habitats and ecology of our pets' wild relatives at the Arizona-Sonora Desert Museum followed by two days at the Humane Society caring for a variety of pets.
