## **Sand Penstemon**

## Penstemon ambiguus

**DESCRIPTION:** This shrub-like deciduous species forms a semi-woody mound to 3' X 3'. Masses of pale pink to white flowers cover the plant in the summer. It re-seeds in the landscape. It is native to the southwest at elevations from 4,500 to 6,000 feet, where it grows in sandy soils.

**RECOMMENDED USE:** Use as an accent, for its summer color, or in a patio container in a bright location.

## **CULTURE:**

Hardiness: -20°F.



**Sun tolerance**: Plant in full sun



**Watering and feeding**: Once established, irrigate infrequently, but regularly. Feed in the spring.



Soil requirements: Needs excellent drainage,



**Pruning**: As needed to tidy its appearance.
