PLANT CARE INFORMATION

Sunrise TM Bells

 $Tecoma \times Sunrise^{TM}$

DESCRIPTION: This Mountain States Wholesale Nursery selection has a lengthy bloom period, producing showy spikes of orange-yellow flowers from spring to fall. SunriseTM has a burnished copper color on the flower buds and the back of the inflorescence. This plant has a clean habit, as it drops old, spent flowers quickly. It doesn't set seed until late in the season, which means a constant supply of new blossoms during the summer. Hummingbirds are drawn to the blooms. In warmer regions, the plant may reach 8' tall and wide.

RECOMMENDED USE: Use as a colorful accent, border, or in a well-lit patio container.

CULTURE:

Hardiness: 10°F.



Sun tolerance: Full sun to part shade.



Watering and feeding: Low to moderate. Feed in spring and early summer.



Soil requirements: Any soil that drains will do.



Pruning: If frost damage should occur, cut the plant back in early spring to rejuvenate growth.
