Rosewood or Arbol Prieto
Vauquelinia corymbosum heterodon

DESCRIPTION: Rosewood is a versatile large shrub or small tree from 10-25' tall and wide. Evergreen leaves are long and narrow, with a dark green color. Creamy-white flowers appear from May to July. This rosewood is native to southwest Texas and northern Mexico along mountainsides from 5000 to 6500'.

RECOMMENDED USE: Can be trained as a multi-trunk tree, windbreak, hedge, or left to grow as a large, informal shrub.
