ARIZONA-SONORA DESERT MUSEUM PLANT CARE INFORMATION

Outback Sunrise Emubush *Eremophila glabra* ‘Mingenew Gold’

DESCRIPTION: Outback Sunrise Emubush is native to Australia, but thrives in our extreme Sonoran Desert heat. Outback Sunrise withstands full sun and reflected heat, but will also perform well in light shade. It is very drought tolerant once established, and it grows quickly. Masses of tubular yellow flowers cover the plant through the spring. It grows quickly to a foot tall and 6’-10’ wide.

RECOMMENDED USE: A great evergreen, durable groundcover

CULTURE:



Hardiness: 15°F.



Sun tolerance: Full sun to part shade.



Watering and feeding: Low water use. Fertilization not necessary.



Soil requirements: Any soil will do.



Pruning: None needed.
