PLANT CARE INFORMATION

Rio Bravo ® Ranger

Leucophyllum langmaniae

DESCRIPTION: This dense evergreen shrub has a rounded form, with lush, deep green leaves. It can grow to 5' by 5' and is best planted where it needs no pruning. Lavender flowers are produced on and off during the summer and fall during periods of high humidity. It thrives in full sun and reflected heat locations. Space Rio Bravo® plants five feet apart and allow them to grow naturally, without shearing.

RECOMMENDED USE: Use as a colorful accent, low screen or barrier

CULTURE:

Hardiness: 10°F.



Sun tolerance: Full sun for best form and flowering.



Watering and feeding: Low water use.



Soil requirements: prefers well-drained soils.



Pruning: This selection of Texas Ranger has a particularly dense rounded form, requiring very little pruning if sited thoughtfully.
