

ARIZONA-SONORA DESERT MUSEUM PLANT CARE INFORMATION

Mexican Evening Primrose Oenothera speciosa 'Syskiyou'

DESCRIPTION: This herbaceous perennial has small green leaves and produces carpets of delicate light to dark pink flowers each spring to mid-summer. It spreads by rhizomes to 3' or more. The medium green leaves may turn red in autumn. Birds feast on the seeds produced after flowering.

RECOMMENDED USE: (accent, specimen, shade, form, color, screen, barrier, ground cover, border, enhanced desert landscape or xeriscape, patio container, hanging pot, attract wildlife, etc.)

CULTURE:

Hardiness: -20°F.

Sun tolerance: Plant in full sun or part shade.



Watering and feeding: Plants can be invasive in wetter landscapes.



Soil requirements: Any soil that drains.

Pruning: If the foliage burns back from the cold or heat, prune heavily and new foliage will regenerate from underground stems.
